T-Clamps may be cleaned using warm water and detergent such as Alconox®, including use in a sonic cleaner. Cold disinfectant solutions, including Cidex®, may be used by soaking.

Steam autoclave parameters: Prevacuum sterilizer | 4 preconditioning pulses | 132°C | 4-minute full cycle | 30-minute dry time | Individually double pouched.
